

# Canal Winchester Volleyball



Dear High School Volleyball Players,

This letter is for any girl that feels she may have an interest in playing volleyball for Canal Winchester next fall. At the high school we have three teams. These teams are freshman, reserve and varsity. All three teams typically practice everyday after school. Games are normally played Tuesday and Thursday with some Saturday matches. Games nights are often triple headers.

Participation in **volleyball**, as with all fall sports, requires you to give up a small portion of your summer. Our **try-outs** will be on **Monday, August 10th 2009** in the high school gym. The time is yet to be determined. If you wait for school to begin to express an interest in volleyball, it will be too late to be considered for the 2009 school team. So, please put this date on your calendar.

If you think you might be interested in trying out, you may also want to come to the **Canal Winchester Volleyball Camp**. This camp runs the week of June 15th and is held in the high school gymnasium. Registration forms are available now on the CW Sports Web site [www.canalwinchestersports.com](http://www.canalwinchestersports.com) You can also get a form from Coach Ross at the middle school. This camp is a good camp no matter what your skill level. It is for the advanced player as well as the beginner. One of the other unique things about our volleyball camp is that girls from other schools are also welcome to attend.

In order to try out for volleyball, you must have a completed physical form. The physical must have been completed within the last year. Physicals are good for one calendar year. Physicals are being offered at the high school on May 28<sup>th</sup> 2009 for \$15. This is a great opportunity to get all of the paperwork filled out and turned into the athletic department before your season. You may choose to go to your own doctor. It really does not matter as long as you have the physical.

Finally, if you make the team, there is a pay- to- participate fee. The exact amount is dependent upon the outcome of the May levy. The fee will be \$140.00 per student if the levy passes and \$535.00 per student if the levy should fail. Please note this fee is for volleyball only. The fee is per activity, NOT per year.
